MAIN PURPOSE OF THE JOB

Responsible for setting up, maintaining, and operating and IT and Broadcast related systems. Will also facilitate the production process through the provision and operating of equipment needed for the success of productions.

KEY RESULT AREAS OF THIS ROLE

1. Maintain logs of production activities
2. Operate control consoles for sound, lighting or video
3. Monitor strength, clarity, and reliability of incoming and outgoing signals and adjust equipment as necessary to maintain quality broadcasts.
4. Monitor broadcasting operations to ensure proper functioning.
5. Report equipment problems, ensure that repairs are made, and make emergency repairs to equipment when necessary and possible.
6. Installing and configuring computer hardware, software, systems, networks, printers and scanners
7. Operate and maintaining specialist equipment for video production, broadcast, satellite transmission and interactive media
8. Operating broadcast equipment
9. Setting up and operating equipment and transmission links during broadcasts
10. Planning and undertaking scheduled maintenance upgrades
11. Setting up accounts for staff, ensuring that they know how to log in i.e. solving password problems
12. IT support for offices, edit suites, gallery and other production areas;
13. Investigating, diagnosing and solving computer software and hardware faults
14. Take note and report on equipment needing replacement or specialist components, fixtures or fittings
15. Maintaining records of software licenses
16. Reporting on stocks of equipment, consumables and other supplies.
